IEP TIMELINE

Please follow the IEP timeline and all weeks notices, including opening the IEP in WebKIDSS, 6 weeks before the IEP date, and have the IEP draft ready and submitted for review. Be sure to send home a draft IEP for family review and input **UNLESS** it is an initial IEP.

SEPTEMBER 20TH IS NEARLY HERE!

September 20 is a <u>critical</u> SPED financial count day!

You must accept or amend new IEPs and complete new placements on or before September 20. Any new evals should be given priority to meet this date.

Have a new student?

We must accept or amend within 5 school days!

Have an exiting student?

Be sure to notify Diana Phillips within 5 school days! (phillpsd@usd320.com)

REMINDERS

- Mileage forms are due the 25th of every month.
- Please complete your annual required training as soon as possible. It's important to complete all the trainings by August 31.

Random Moment Time Study

Your participation helps your school receive federal funds for activities done that are necessary to provide students with health-related services like speech therapy.
